

TEAMBUILDING with THEATRE

WORKSHOP OVERVIEW

Ask any actor about creating theatre with others and they will tell you about the bond that develops in any ensemble that they are a part of! Theatre brings people together, reveals and strengthens the dynamics of a group and produces positive relationships between the people creating it.

Based on the first principle of improvisation – saying "Yes, and..." – this 3-hour workshop will encourage participants to say yes to each other's ideas and to build upon them. Participants will be led through a series of carefully structured drama activities, leading up to the creation of their very own short piece of theatre.

KEY OBJECTIVES

- 1. Rediscover team relationships through drama games and improvisation
- 2. Examine group dynamics in a fun, interactive, structured and safe environment
- 3. Discover new strengths and talents through creating a short piece of theatre together

METHODOLOGY

INTERACTIVE and FUN: This workshop will have you on your feet from the get-go! You will play games and participate in drama activities in the same way that actors do in the rehearsal room.

PLAYFUL and INSIGHTFUL: The workshop will reveal participants' strengths and natural dispositions in a playful manner.

KEY COMPONENTS

BUILDING ENSEMBLE

- Getting in sync with each other
- Learning about each other

SAYING "YES, AND..."

- Responding to each other's cues
- Accepting and building on each other's ideas

CREATING TOGETHER

- Assigning roles based on each person's strengths
- Working cohesively to create a piece of theatre together
